Guidelines for scholarship application to attend the 12APFSSH / 8APFSHT Congress 11-14 March 2020 • Melbourne, Australia

12APFSSH/8APFSHT Congress is pleased to be able to offer financial assistance to selected Occupational Therapists or Physiotherapists from developing countries within Asia Pacific to attend the Congress in 2020. Funding available may cover Congress registration and/or contribute towards return economy flights from the applicant's relevant capital city.

Eligibility criteria for sponsorship include:

- A qualified Physiotherapist or Occupational Therapist
- Employment within an eligible country within Asia Pacific as outlined on the APFSHT Congress website <http://temp.icmsaust.com.au/Developing-Nations-List.pdf>
- Leadership or active participation in developing Hand Therapy as a specialty practice area in his/her country, with at least 2 years of hand therapy experience.
- Candidates must have satisfactory written and spoken English comprehension to benefit fully from the Congress
- Be willing to be hosted in a fellow therapists home for the duration of the Congress, or, fund their own accommodation.

Identification of Successful Candidates:

Candidates are expected to report on Congress findings to their home organisation/ society/ colleagues and will be required to submit their plan in their application.

Therapists can self-nominate, along with the endorsement of two of the following:

- Their professional leads
- An orthopaedic or plastic surgeon they work with
- A hand therapist from a IFSHT member country who has visited or worked with the nominating therapist in a qualifying country

Priority will be given to:

- Applicants who have submitted an abstract (either a poster or oral presentation) for the Congress
- Applicants from member countries of the International Federation of Societies of Hand Therapy
- Applicants whose economic status makes self-funding challenging or impossible

Procedure

The therapist seeking financial assistance is required to complete the application and forward it to the organising committee prior to 15th of June 2019. All successful candidates and their nominating person will be notified by the organising committee by the 1st of December 2019.
